It will be powered by a G 26 motor and he intends to use it for training. He also brought along some of his Cub parts to show the completed covering and sealcoat technique.

Bob Kelliher showed the two piece fuselage for the "Giant scale Stick" that he is building from a lazer cut kit. He made the fuselage in two pieces so that it would fit in the back of his truck. It will have a 120" wingspan and will be powered by a DLE 111 twin.

A 50/50 raffle was held after the meeting, Glenn Metzler was the lucky winner.
