

SWAP MODELERS DECEMBER 2017 MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm at the Glen Burnie ShopRite store. November's meeting minutes were read and accepted. The treasurer's report was given and also accepted. This year's award of appreciation was presented to Michael Lewis aka Trinidad Mike for his outstanding service to the Club.

It was reported that there has been a problem with the lock at entrance gate again. Some members are leaving the lock open and hanging unsecured on the chain after opening the gate. The lock should be closed and the combination scrambled after being unlocked. Pat Murphy said that he would try to weld the lock to the chain although the county has not replaced their lock on the other end of the chain.

Tone Herold showed the new multirotor that he has built. It is based on the Sky Hero/Sky Trooper and is of a Y stick design with coaxial rotors, each powered by its own motor and speed control. It has many unique features and is powered by a 6 cell battery and can lift nearly 22lbs. Tone also showed a 105mm HSD F16 EDF jet with a 51" wingspan flying on a 12 cell lipo. The craft develops 16lbs of thrust and has some nice custom and scale features that Tone incorporated himself.
