

SWAP MODELERS APRIL 2019 MEETING'S MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm at the Swap Modeler's flying field, Pat Murphy president presiding. March's meetings minutes were read and accepted. The treasurer's report was given and also accepted. Art explained that he is keeping a separate account for the field improvement project. Pat Murphy suggested that if anyone hears of any fill dirt available to try to have it delivered to our field.

Art Vail announced that some members still haven't paid their membership fees for the upcoming year. He said that their names will be posted inside the shed and that if they are observed flying at the field, they need to be told that their membership has lapsed.

Art thanked all those who helped out with the field cleanup day and also thanked Glenn Metzler for helping to organize the field improvement project. Art said he had noticed that the average age of those participating was approximately 68.5.

The next Club event will be a "Fun Fly" May 25th. A motion was made and passed to make the price of the Club member "all you can eat" \$15.00 and have the proceeds go toward the field improvement project.

Bob Pollokoff spoke about the meeting that he and Glenn had with Park Maintenance officials about having the Park maintenance department do some of the fill and grading of the field. They looked over the problem areas and listened to our concerns and said they would see what they could do.

Glenn Metzler went over some of the goals for our field improvements, some of which are the filling of low spots on the field, repair to the picnic tables, repair to the chain-link fencing, repair to the driveway and parking area, and rolling the field. He admitted that we are basically waiting to hear from the county to see what they will do for us before we invest any more of our time and money. Glenn said that we might be able to get some asphalt millings at a low cost but they could only be delivered at night when the road work was being done. Art said he could talk to the person who closes the main gate about getting a key and Tone Herald said that he would be willing to let the trucks in.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm 24 members attending. Next meeting will be May 20th at 6:30pm at the Club field.
