

SWAP MODELERS MAY 2019 MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm at the Club field, Pat Murphy president presiding. April's meeting minutes were read and accepted. The treasurer's report was given and also accepted. At this time, the Club's finances are on a par with last year. Art Vail stated that some members still have not renewed their membership and that raffle ticket monies need to be turned in. Art also read off the list of the most recent donations to the "field improvement fund" and the current balance.

Pat Murphy asked if there were any new members present.

Members were reminded that the Club's first fun fly was coming up and that fliers for the September event will soon be available. Art also said that the tickets for the "Crab and Beer" raffle to benefit the DAV will be printed soon.

Glenn Metzler spoke briefly about the "Field Improvement Project". He outlined some of the projects that still need to be done but stated that we are basically waiting to see what the County Parks will do for us. He also said that the AMA approved our request for flying field assistance and will be sending the Club a check for 10% of the total estimate of the project. Glenn reported that he had seen two teenagers on an ATV at the Field and that they had apparently done some "burnouts" on the field itself.

Kieth Wilson inquired about the feasibility of installing taxiways at the runway end. After some discussion, it was decided that it could not be easily done.

A 50/50 drawing was held at the end of the meeting. Digger Drury was the lucky winner.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 pm, 22 members attending. Next meeting will be at the Club field, June 17th at 6:30 pm.
